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## DISEASE/DISORDER

### General

- Ex. **Most common** etiology, demographics/populations affected, risk factors, and basic anatomy & pathophysiology high-yields if applicable.

### Clinical Presentation (signs & symptoms)

- Make sure to make your **most common** s/sx or **buzzwords** stand out for quick review
- Add any images for reference using *copy -> paste -> right click on photo -> move within text vs square with text* (→ example)

### Diagnostics

- Include any **screening vs. diagnostic labs** here including **your most common and/or gold standard** (not always one in the same)
- **Imaging** including **buzzword presentations/descriptions** with images included for reference

### Treatment

- **First line/ treatment of choice**
- Include Other outpatient vs. inpatient treatment options
- If applicable, be sure to include **preventative treatment options**
- **!** Include **high yield adverse effects** of treatment options (one or two words to jog memory)

### Complications/ Prognosis

- Ex complications from disorder itself regardless of treatment, complications of not treating vs. increased risks overtime (ex. cardiovascular risks, cancers.) from exposure
- Prognosis and barriers to good prognosis
